Organization: Preterm's mission is to advance reproductive health and justice by providing safe, respectful, and accessible abortion and sexual healthcare.

Abortion is essential to bodily autonomy and gender equity for all people. Providing abortions is a deeply caring and revolutionary act that is part of dismantling oppression and stigma. These are the values that guide Preterm's commitment to abortion care.

Job Title: Patient Advocate

Job Status: Full or part time, non-exempt

Reports to: Director of Counseling Services

Job Summary: If you're committed to reproductive health, rights and justice, come join our team in providing compassionate abortion and sexual health care at Preterm. We have always been a nonprofit health clinic dedicated to keeping high-quality healthcare accessible to everyone, regardless of income. We are a state licensed, AAAHC certified ambulatory surgery center in Cleveland, Ohio.

Patient Advocates work with patients seeking abortion to assess their psychological readiness for an abortion, to obtain informed consent, to assist in their choice of birth control, and to support them through the abortion. Patient Advocates must maintain an unbiased approach to unintended pregnancy and support a person's decision. Must have strong listening and communication skills, be nonjudgmental, be able to convey warmth and caring, and be able to work as part of a team of care providers.

Salary: starts at \$16/hour

Benefits: benefits for staff working 28 hours or more a week include paid time off, group health insurance, short-term and long-term disability insurance, and a retirement plan.
